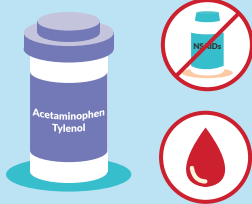


# Acetaminophen (brand: Tylenol)

## Indication:

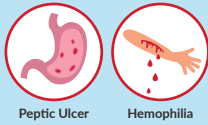
Fever & mild pain. Used instead of NSAIDs to decrease bleeding risk



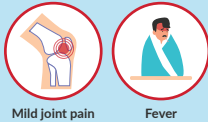
## Key Points:

### A - Absence of BLEEDING

- Like in patients with Peptic Ulcer or Hemophilia



- Mild joint pain or Fever



- Another Plus is that Tylenol & NSAIDs can be used interchangeably to reduce fever



- When you reach max dose on one you can use the other



- So it's recommended for child with flu



### A - Alcohol history (Liver Toxic)
